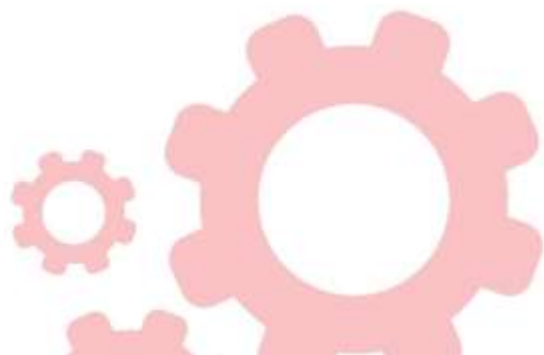

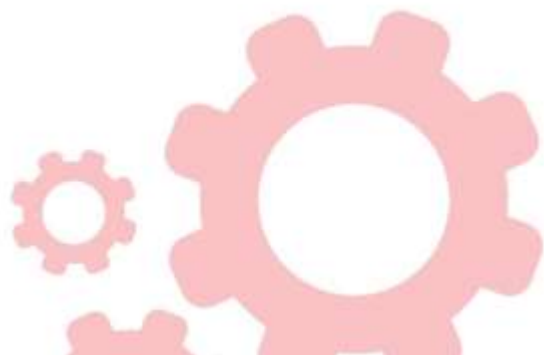

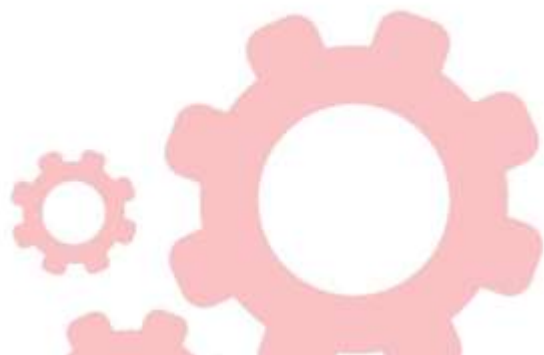
In addition to the transfer of the theoretical methodological knowledge, the training offers the opportunity for the participating professionals to study the practical implementation of each methodological elements, development tools and activities.

Optional dates for 3x5 day trainings:

- 25 - 29. of April 2022.
- 16 - 20 of May 2022.
- 30 of May - 3 of June 2022.

All three methods of transfer workshops are implemented on the basis of the same thematic, detailed in the attached program.

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Participation in the methodological workshop is free of charge, full board and accommodation are provided in two-bed rooms for participants who live further away from Pécs. Dinner is provided for all participants, considering the special needs indicated on the application form.

Croatian-Hungarian interpreter is ensured throughout the methodological knowledge transfer training. Travelling to the first day to Pécs

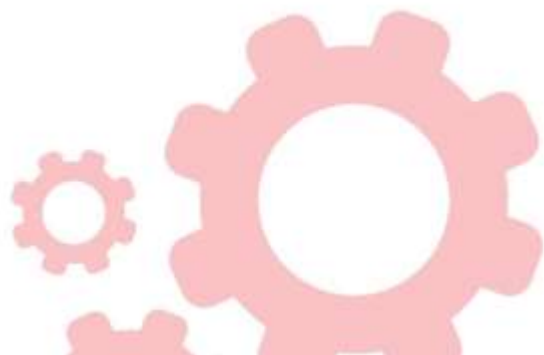
