The overall objective of the project is to expand the partnership between Zrinska Garda Čakovec (ZGČ) and Szigetvári Kultúr- és Zöld Zóna Egyesület (SzkZZ), to broaden civic relations between the two twin towns, to strengthen connections and encourage new encounters. The joint programmes and events of the project develop the framework for cooperation. New contacts, social interaction and engagement will be created between the twin-town communities, and their shared cultural and historical identity will be strengthened through mutual learning.

The specific objective of the project is to promote the development of bilateral cross-border links and to maintain shared values. In line with this objective, the project implements elements that provide opportunities for joint participation and cooperation. We intend to achieve our specific objectives through joint summer camps, international sports championships and cultural programmes linked to the Days of the Zrinski (historical festival) event series, in Szigetvár as well as in Čakovec.
